

Cookies Policy

- 1. The website does not automatically collect any information except for the information contained in cookies.
- 2. Cookies ("cookies") are computer data, especially text files that are stored in the user's computer and are intended for use on the website. Cookies usually include the name of the website from which they came from, their retention time on the computer, and a unique number.
- 3. The owner of the site ()VarsoviaFX LTD) is placing cookies and accessing them contact information is placed in the "contact" page.
- 4. Cookies can be used for:
- 5. Customizing the content of the website to user preferences and optimizing the use of the website. In particular, these files allow the website to recognize user's device and display a web page adjusted to user's individual needs;
- 6. Creating statistics that help the owner understand how customers are using the website, so that website's structure and content is improved;
- 7. Keeping user's website session (after logging in), so that user does not have to re-enter the login and password on each page of the website;
- 8. Within the website, two main types of cookies are used: "session cookies" and "persistent cookies". "Session" cookies are temporary files that are stored on user's device until log out, leaving the website, or disabling the software (web browser). "Persistent" cookies are stored in the user's computer for the time specified in the cookie parameters or until the user deletes them.
- 9. The following types of cookies may be used within the Service:
- 10. "Necessary" cookies, which allow you to use the services available on the website, such as authenticating cookies used for services requiring authentication on the website;
- 11. "Secure" cookies for security purposes, such as those used to detect abuse in the matters of authentication on the website;
- 12. "Performance" cookies collecting information about how the website is used;
- 13. "Functional" cookies that allow to "memorize" user-selected settings and personalization of the user interface, such as the selected language or region from which the User originates, the font size, the appearance of the website, etc.;
- 14. "Advertising" cookies, which allow the website to provide more customized advertising content to user's interests.
- 15. In many cases, web browser software (web browser) in its default settings allows cookies to be stored on user's device. Users may change cookies settings at any time. These settings may be changed to block automatic cookie handling in web browser, or to notify about posting new cookies on the computer each time. Detailed information on the features and ways of handling cookies is available in the software settings (web browser).
- 16. The Service Provider informs that restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the website.
- 17. Cookies posted on the user's computer may also be used by advertisers and partners who cooperate with the owner of the website.
